Microsoft announced its plans to support **Sun Microsystems'** Java and JavaScript development tools in upcoming releases of its server and client Internet software.

Although now state-of-the-art, Java applets will become standard development tools within the next few months.

Office 95 Released

Microsoft has released an upgrade to its popular software application suite: Microsoft Office.

All new versions of Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access are included in the Office 95 Professional package.

New features include greater ability to share data between programs, including linking Excel spreadsheet data into Word documents, and PowerPoint graphics into Word documents, Excel spreadsheets, and Access tables.

The complete installation requires approximately 190 MB of hard disk space, and a minimum of 8 MB of RAM. Windows 95 is required as the operating system, which requires up to 121 MB of disk space itself.

Copies are available now at local software resellers and computer stores.

1 GB May Not Be Enough

Just a year ago, most computer users thought it would never happen—a one gigabyte (1 GB) hard disk would never fill up.

Today, most major computer manufacturers offer 1.6 GB and larger hard drives as standard equipment.

With software suites and their operating systems requiring over 300 MB, it's little wonder that we need such large disk drives.

The good news for those of us with older computers—the new drives are cheap! Most stores offer 1.2 and 1.6 GB drives for about 300 - 500 dollars.
