### Win95 Security Bug Fix

Microsoft has posted a patch aimed at protecting users from an attack that could crash Windows 95 PCs.

The fix for the so-called "out of band [OOB] data" bug.

The bug is caused when a website site sends a TCP/IP command with OOB data to port 139 of a Win95 PC.

The U.S. Postal Service will begin using the Web to sell U.S. postage stamps.

The post office will begin testing the sale of postage stamps online this fall in a limited number of metropolitan markets yet to be chosen, according to USPS spokesman Mark Saunders.

The USPS has made significant efforts to cater to the online audience. One visit to the USPS website makes this clear. Users can look up 9-digit ZIP codes, track express packages, check postal rates and the physical address of post offices.

Netscape's Bob Lisbonne said the product, Netscape Netcaster, would be available in the new Communicator when it ships next month. He also said Netscape expected the push paradigm to catch on among both consumers and corporate customers alike.

Netscape's technology uses software from Palo Alto, California-based Marimba. Marimba's software enables media companies to deliver software and information to users tuned into a specific channel, like a television.

Thousands of channels are expected by year's end.
