3Com has confirmed that upgrading its 56Kbps Megahertz notebook modem from the proprietary x2 to the newly-accepted industry standard v.90 format may destroy the modem.

The glitch occurs in two U.S. Robotics (owned by 3Com) Megahertz laptop models: the XJ1560 and the CC1560.
